The event was a great success, we tested 86 men of which 78 men received Green results, 5 received Amber results and 4 received Red results. Home Test Kits Now Available!.....

Since we made the decision to postpone the test events we had planned for this year, we have been contacted by men who have found that due to Covid-19 their own GP's and hospitals were not carrying out tests. They were unable to continue with their surveillance and were insisting they needed help. These men were very anxious and needed a solution to their problem. So in conjunction with the Graham Fulford Charitable Trust, we are launching a PSA home test kit. This small finger prick test can be ordered online and performed in the comfort of your own home.
